That the grartee shall supervise the said facilities and cause them to be inspected at reasonable intervals, and shall immediately repair any defects found therein as a result of such inspection, or when reques od by said officer to repair any defects. Upon completion of the installation of said facilities and the making of any repairs thereto, the premises shall be restored immediately by the grantee, at the grantee's own expense, to the same condition as that in which they existed prior to the commencement of such work, to the satisfaction of the said officer. The grantee's all have the right of ingress and egress for the purposes.
- 6. That my property of the United States damaged or destroyed by the grantee incident to the use and occupation of the said premises shall be promptly repaired or replaced by the grantee to the satisfaction of the said officer, or in lieu of such repair or replacement the grantee shall if so required by the said officer, pay to the United States money in an amount sufficient to compensate for the loss sustained by the United States by reason of damage to or destruction of Government property.
- 7. That the United States reserves to itself the right to construct, use, and maintain across, over, and/or under the right-of-way hereby granted, electric transmission, telephone, telegraph, water, gus, gasoline, oil, and sewer lines, and other facilities, in such manner as not to create any unreasonable interference with the use of the r 'tof-way herein granted.
- 8. That the United States shall not be responsible for any damages to property or injuries to persons which may arise from or be incident to the use and occupation of the said premises, oxfor damages to the property of the grantee, or for injuries to the person of the grantee (if an individual), or for damages to the property or injuries to the person of the grantee's officers, agents, servants, or employees, or others who may be on said premises at their invitation or the invitation of any one of them, arising from or incident to governmental activities; and the grantee shall hold the United States harmless from any and all such claims.
- 9. That the United States shall not be responsible for damages to property or injuries to persons which may arise from or be incident to the construction, maintenance, and use of said facilities.
- 10. That the grantee shall furnish through said facilities such service as may be required from time to time for governmental surpless present that for the fact have not for all such service will be made by the United States results which shall be mutdely typicalote but which shall never exceed the most favorable rates grunted by the grantee for similar service.
- 11. That, in the event all or any portion of said land occupied by said facilities shall be needed by the United States, or in the event the existence of said facilities shall be considered detrimental to governmental activities, the grantee shall, from time to time, upon notice so to do, and as often as so notified, remove said facilities to such other location or locations on said land as may be designated by said officer, or the grantee shall reconstruct said facilities underground on said land without expense to the United States, as may be directed by said officer, and in the event said property shall not be removed or relocated within ninety (90) days after any aforesaid notice, the United States may cause the same to be done at the expense of the grantee, provided, however, that if directed to reconstruct its facilities underground the grantee may, at its option, in lieu of taking such action, wholly remove its facilities from lands of the United States as described herein, at which time the right granted herein shall cease but the restoration obligation set forth in Condition No. 13 hereof shall remain.

That upon the expiration, termination, or forfeiture and annulment of this grant, the grantce shall, without expense to the United States, and within such time as the Secretary of the Army may indicate, remove said facilities from said land and restore the premises hereby authorized to be used and occupied to a condition satisfactory to the said officer. In the event the grantee shall fail, neglect, or refuse to remove the said facilities and so restore the premises, the United States shall have the option either to take over the said facilities as the property of the United States without compensation therefor, or to remove said facilities and perform the restoration work as aforesaid at the expense of the grantee, and in no event shall the grantee have any claim for damages against the United States, or its officers or agents, on account of the taking over of said facilities or on account of their removal.
- 14. That the provisions and conditions of this instrument shall extend to and be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, representatives, successors, and assigns of the yrance.
- 15. That it is understood that this instrument is effective only insofar as the rights of the United States in the said property are concerned; and that the grantee shall obtain such permission as may be necessary on account of any other existing rights:

That prior to the esecution of this easement, conditions were deleted, revised and added in the following manner:

- 16. That adequate precautions will be taken by the grantee to prevent damages to fences, roads, entrance ways, water lines, electric transmission lines, telephone cables and any other facilities that may be on the premises.
- 1 17. As one of the conditions of this easement, the new railroad classification yard must be constructed by the grantee at its expense. Plans and specifications for the yard must be approved before construction. Continuing inspection of the classification yard during the construction period will be done by the U.S. Army, Corps of Engineers at the expense of the grantee. The cc pleted classification yard and the power line must be approved before the line is energized.

That prior to the execution of this in homent, Condition No. 10 was deleted; Condition No. 12 was revised; Conditions Nos. 16, 17 and 18 were added. Condition No. 18 on separate page attached hereto and made a part hereof.

This easement is not subject to Title 10, United States Code, Section 2662.
